Place



The course will take place at HOTEL ZAIRA (www.hotel-zaira.gr) in Skala Loutron, a village

located at the south east of Lesvos. Skala Loutron is 8 km away from Mytilene, the capital of the island. Lesvos is connected by airplane with Athens and Thessaloniki. Olympic Airlines and Aegean Airlines fly with approx. 6 flights per day (1 hour flight). Charter flights (generally once per week) connect Mytilene with various European cities during the summer months. Check with your local travel agencies. Ferries travel from Piraeus to Mytilene everyday, and sometimes twice per day (8 or 12 hours voyage, depending on the ferry).

Fees and Accommodation-Boarding

The total cost of this training courses is 1230 euros. This amount includes the course fee, accommodation and full boarding at Hotel Zaira, and it is divided as follows:

Course fee: 670 euro
Accommodation (single room) and full boarding for 7 days: 560 euro
